Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

As we enter the month of July, often a sabbath month at Bethlehem, I'd like to pose this reflective question: what is the first thing you think of as you awake each day? Maybe it's a question ("How might today be a better day?") Maybe your mind rushes to a list of tasks or a way in which you might be refreshed with a day of rest or sabbath. Maybe your train of thought is something as general as pain relief or parental responsibility. Perhaps it's as simple as "I need coffee!"

This month, we "awake" to a 6-page STAR for the first time in years. After some reflection and a bit of innovation, we are paring down the physical size of our newsletter, for a few reasons: one, for stewardship – both saving money, paper (and trees!). Secondarily, we hope to encourage a little brevity and simplicity. We still want all your ideas and articles. Yet, presenting them a little more concisely seems a good way to use both paper (STAR) and website (e.g. for fuller detail) What is "missing," you might ask? Actually, not much. Our leaders have committed to cutting down their pages from full pages to a partial pages, and our monthly Council minutes will now have a link to our website (see below) so that if you wish to read them, you can easily get the full minutes online.

**Moving forward, we have two exciting updates for worship.** First, we have formalized our "Second Sunday" traditional worship service to become official practice at BLC. Every second Sunday of the month, we will have a traditional liturgy, with organ and sung Kyrie and Great Thanksgiving, all four scripture readings, and so forth.

We are also planning something new in the fall called "Third Thursday." Here we invite all those looking for an in-person sabbath/worship alternative to Sunday to join us each third Thursday evening of the month for a worship style similar to our "Celebrate" (formerly Saturday) liturgy. We will offer communion with Taize, Holden Evening Prayer, a Jazz Vespers service, a Hymn/Song Sing or "Celebrate" liturgy with all-contemporary music. This arrangement also allows us to utilize the presence and gifts of our new shared choir director, Tony Bero, who cannot normally join us on the weekends. We will begin our "Third Thursday" worship at 7pm on September 15<sup>th</sup>.

Finally, having just returned from the first week of summer camp at Stony Lake since 2019, I am reminded of the process of growing into a "next normal" following a pandemic. As we look to the future, we do so knowing that God is with us always, helping us move forward – changed, transformed and yet very much the same body of Christ for the world. Much peace to you all, and God bless!



### **New Idea for Some New Trees!**

Recently the Bethlehem Mission Endowment Fund bought 5 trees for \$500.00 that we planted at the Old Sabin Dam site near the end of Cass Rd.

The trees are about 75 feet from the river and on a bank that is not that steep and they are near the parking lot. They can be seen from the parking lot so they will easy to find. They need to be watered once a week for this summer to get them established and then they will be on their own. They will survive and be a blessing to many, both human and non-human.

### IDEA: What if we have 5 people sign up to ADOPT A BLC TREE?

We can call it, "The 5 BUCKET GROUP" Each will get a bucket and they can water their tree any time, either with others or alone. A full 5 gallon bucket of water weighs 42 pounds, so this project is not for everyone.

### **Refresh Committee Updates**

The Refresh Committee held several meetings in the past month regarding renovations at Bethlehem. We welcome all questions, comments and ideas. On May 7, the first women pastors were ordained in the **Evangelical Church of the Augsburg Confession in Poland.** The ceremony, which took place in Warsaw at Holy Trinity Church, marked the conclusion of a discussion about women's ordination that has been ongoing for decades. Several ELCA representatives were able to attend and celebrate this joyous milestone with our partner church in Poland.

The nine women who took their vows were already serving the church as deacons. Rev. Karina Chwastek-Kamieniorz, who works in the largest country parish of Goleszów in southern Poland, noted that from a practical perspective, she will continue doing the same pastoral work she has done for many years. But she said she hoped the decision to ordain women would bring equality of salaries and an end to discrimination against women in the church.

Rooted and built in Jesus! This is the core of our work as the ELCA walks with more than 80 companion churches in other countries to participate in God's reconciling mission through proclamation and service. Participating in these relationships, ELCA members see how people's lives are touched by the gospel, how their lives are transformed and renewed, and how their communities live in hope.
