

Worship

Celebrate! Worship

Join us on <u>Saturday evenings at 5:00pm</u> for a relaxed liturgy and upbeat worship service! This service focuses on singing and Scripture and includes Communion each week. Music is typically led by guitar, piano, and other instruments. Worship style is usually contemporary but varies on the 4th Saturday of the month, with a more contemplative Holden Evening Prayer or Taize worship. The 1st and 3rd Saturdays of the month include pre-worship jam-sessions with the *Celebrate!* band (15 min. before service.)

Traditional Worship

Join us on **Sunday mornings at 8:45am** for a lively yet traditional Lutheran service. Our Traditional worship features mostly organ music; the choir often participate with more traditional songs and hymns; portions of the liturgy are sung or chanted; Communion is received at the altar; and leading ministers wear traditional worship attire.

Modern Worship

Join us on <u>Sunday mornings at 11am</u> for a modern style Lutheran service. The Modern service is a structured service that allows for freedom and flexibility in the ways worship is shaped, while focusing on what we hold in common with our tradition. Musical style and instrumentation vary between organ, piano and other contemporary pieces.

Jubilee Services

Join us on the 5th Sunday of a month (occurring roughly four times/year) for a "one-service weekend" at 10am followed by 11:30am potluck meal. (No worship is held the Saturday prior.) This service gives us the opportunity to get to know our "Bethlehem Church family" better, while at the same time welcoming visitors from the community as the whole church. The worship style of this service varies.

Worship Teams (All Services)

Altar Guild: Prepares the altar for worship and Communion **Assisting Ministers:** Assists the pastor during the worship service and helps serve Communion.

A/V Team: Sits in the balcony & manages the weekly "Screenouncements" and worship power point presentations (Sat. 5pm/Sun 11am). Also operates sound system for music/worship teams

Lector: Reads the Scripture lessons at worship services.

Hospitality: Greets people at the door and hands out bulletins.

Parish Choir: Sings at different services each month. Rehearsal Weekly. **Hand Bell Choir:** Plays approximately once per month in a Traditional and Modern service. Rehearsals Weekly.

Worship Team: Leads music once a month at the *Celebrate!* and Modern services. Rehearsals Weekly.
