
High School Youth


Adults

Worship

Celebrate! Worship

Join us on <u>Saturday evenings at 5:00pm</u> for a relaxed and upbeat worship service! This service focuses on singing and Scripture and includes Communion each week. Music will typically be led by guitar, piano, and other instruments. Worship style will also vary, using Holden Evening Prayer and Taize services approximately once a month.

Traditional Worship

Join us on <u>Sunday mornings at 8:45am</u> for a traditional Lutheran service. For the Traditional service, you will hear mostly organ music instead of piano; the choir will participate in this service with more traditional songs; the Kyrie, Great Thanksgiving (and Psalms occasionally) will usually be chanted; congregants will typically receive Communion at the altar railing; and Pastor Paul will wear a robe and often preach from the pulpit.

Modern Worship

Join us on <u>Sunday mornings at 11am</u> for a modern style Lutheran service. Not unlike the Traditional service, the Modern worship will be structured in its liturgy but will allow for freedom and flexibility with music and style. Piano and other instrumentation will likely be used more frequently than the organ, and leaders and components will be slightly more relaxed in dress and formality. This is the worship service most commonly known by Bethlehemers in the past.
