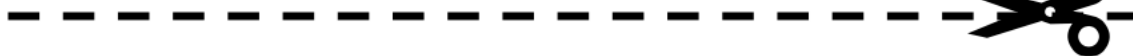
Ways I/we can help Bethlehem move forward this coming year:
