#### **FINANCIAL NEWS**

July income was \$27,998 compared to budgeted income of \$29,454 or a shortfall of \$1,456. Expenses were \$35,368 compared to budget of \$31,995 resulted in spending \$3,373 more than budgeted. On a cash basis expenses exceeded income by \$7,370.

Through July, income was \$202,337 compared to budgeted income of \$210,565 for a shortfall of \$8,228. Expenses were \$218,744 compared to budget of \$216,299 resulted in spending \$2,445 more than budgeted. On a cash basis expenses have exceeded income by \$16,407.



### Facts About the ELCA You May Not Know . . .

- The ELCA Churchwide Assembly met in Columbus, Ohio, August 8-12 to determine and affirm plans and programs for the next triennium (2023-2025).
- 240 missionaries serve in 40 countries around the world.
- There are 37 languages spoken in ELCA congregations across the United States.
- A new ELCA staff person, Vance Blackfox of the Cherokee Nation serves as Director of Indigenous Ministries and Tribal Relations. He will be building relationships with tribes and tribal leaders while partnering with and supporting the Indigenous and Native ministries that have existed and been working in Indian Country for many years.
- The ELCA is affiliated with 20 Lutheran colleges and 7 seminaries.
- Presiding Bishop Elizabeth Eaton serves as regional vice president of the Lutheran World Federation for the Lutheran Communion in North America.
- Mr. Imran Siddiqui was elected vice president of the ELCA. He is a member of St. John's Lutheran Church, Atlanta and has served as vice president of the Southeastern Synod since 2018. He grew up Muslim and became a Lutheran in 2011.
