this is **WESLEY**

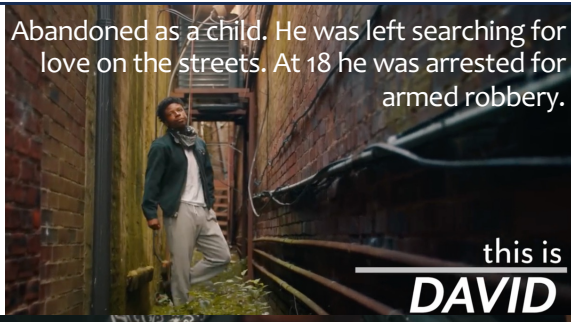
He has been sober for 6 1/2 years and is now the Executive Director of a ministry called Ground 40.

His 10 year heroin addiction led to multiple arrests for possession, theft, and resisting arrest. On his 82nd arrest, while in the Union County jail, two chaplains shared the Good News. And the Spirit rushed in...

Ground 40 helps men break the chains of homelessness, addiction, and incarceration through the power of Christ.

But most importantly, he shared a passion for Jesus and telling others about the change only He can make.

Abandoned as a child. He was left searching for love on the streets. At 18 he was arrested for armed robbery.

During his 5 year sentence, he joined a prison gang. But then God stepped in.

He heard the Gospel at a bible study. Gave his life to Jesus, and laid down his gang affiliation.

After successfully completing the Ground 40 program, he landed a job, a car, and his own place.

In 2018, her son Cody overdosed on heroin. She found his lifeless body on the floor of her home.

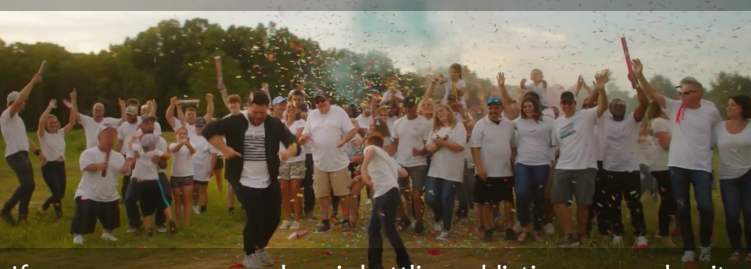


this is **CODY**
