Brief description of the work that the agenda provides:

Teen pregnancy program — up to age 22 5 year nonprofit...used to be the Doula Program Has daycare program on site, Early Headstart now has daycare on site too Helping young people with children get a better start

Strengths within the Traverse City community when it comes to serving our neighbors?

They see collaboration

Father Fred Family Collaborative pulls folks together, sharing resources, services, focused on non profits and the services offered, meets monthly SOS learning lab helping students to complete high school, online learning, located at 14th and Veterans...flexible program dedicated to helping students complete education programs

Where are the gaps, holes, or issues of lacking within our larger community?

Program is in need of vehicles and transportation, many do not have licenses Many barriers for those under 18 getting their licenses

Transportation is needed in general...if they do not have license or vehicle, they do need rides to work, to day care, to doctor appointments, etc.

Driving mentor means that often a mentor is using their own car to teach a nondriver to drive...this then effects the mentor's car insurance, time, possible damage to car, etc.

The current person that has served as a driving mentor is out for the season Needed: from training to transportation to getting driving license

Counseling is also a barrier, not many clinicians take Medicaid...if they do, there is often a risk that the client will not show up which leaves a non-billable counseling session within the clinicians schedule

How might BLC be helpful in filling some of the gaps?

Funding for therapy/counseling

Mentors for transportation/teaching clients how to drive

Baby Pantry support, perhaps sharing resources/products between BLC and Generations Ahead to be sure BLC pantry and Generations Ahead Pantry are both well stocked on an ongoing basis

Involvement in the "Munches" Event, monthly meal and speaker hosting the clients Various topics and presenters to help educate and support the clients Food as well as those willing to mentor and provide program/training for program Male role models/mentors to assistant young fathers
